Re: Ref 21/04271/F Blue Cedar Application

While I understand that our village needs to help provide new homes needed nationally, I feel the 25 already due to be built in Sibford Ferris will put so much extra pressure on the traffic flow in the village, we have reached the limit of what can be coped with.

I live 4 doors from the village shop, a pinch point on the main street through the village. It is not unusual to have grid lock outside my house, as only one vehicle can pass at a time. If a bus is coming from one direction, and a large agricultural vehicle from the other, it leads to one vehicle reversing up to 50 metres. This is even more difficult during periods of busy traffic, as many vehicles have to reverse.

There is no pavement at all for stretches of the main street through the village (which I live on), and no room to put one in due to walls/steep banks. This is dangerous when I am walking out with my 4 year old granddaughter, and an extremely tight squeeze if a large vehicle passes when I am pushing the baby in her pushchair.

I hope my concerns (and those of my neighbours and other village residents) will be taken into consideration when the decision is made on the Blue Cedar application, and that it will be turned down.
