Tree protection fencing often does not appear to completely enclose retained trees, with several groups seemingly protected only from one side. Confirmation required as to why this is, failing that amendment required to ensure retained trees are fully protected by a full CEZ.

The report references arboricultural supervision during no dig access construction. The plan however, does not detail where this no dig access is. The plan will also need to provide methodology for no dig access construction.
