Comments	<input type="text" value="My reason for objecting to this proposed building plan is the lane will almost invariably be shut down with no access during building works. The lane is very narrow and there is absolutely no available parking so with building lorries, tradesmen, skips etc, there will be no through access whatsoever. In addition, the doctor's surgery is almost opposite so blocking the lane with building and supply vehicles will most definitely obstruct access to the surgery. Furthermore, once building is complete, parking will continue to be a problem as the lane is so narrow. As it is there is a great shortage of parking making it difficult for any car to pass through. I not sure the pot-holed lane could cope with large lorries and will become even further damaged. There is no access to the back of the cottage where the extension is proposed which means all the materials will either need to go over the top of the cottage or through the cottage. If it goes through the cottage, the entire cottage will need a refurbishment, adding to the labour, vehicles and traffic in the lane."/>
