| Comments | <input type="text" value="I am writing to strongly object to the proposed commercial development. I have seen the development of Banbury for over fifty years and have seen the impact that it has had, especially on our beautiful countryside that surrounds the town. I am horrified about the devastating effects these new proposed developments would have in this area, especially on the hamlet of Nethercote and Huscote. Before the M40 motorway was built the area was a peaceful, unspoilt and unpolluted area to live in. The noise and pollution created from traffic, since the M40 opened, is bad enough. To consider building more huge, overwhelming warehouses and destroy beautiful countryside seems unbelievable. With the added noise and pollution created from the additional traffic, including articulated lorries, using the proposed warehouses would wipe out local nature and wildlife, (I haven't heard the cuckoo in Nethercote since the motorway opened!). As we all know, nature is vital to our wellbeing and survival, and we need to look after it rather than destroy it. Not only does the proposed development have an effect on those living close by in Nethercote and also Huscote it also has an effect on people who walk in these areas. I use Nethercote lane to safely walk home from Banbury, (where I work during the week). I used to walk up the Overthorpe hill to Middleton Cheney but over the last few years this road has become increasingly more busy and dangerous to walk on, (there is no footpath on the Overthorpe hill). It's certainly no longer safe to cycle along this road either. All types of vehicles use this road, many travelling too fast. (I have noticed that an increase in traffic on the Overthorpe Road is partly due to the recently added developments along Chalker Way). Nethercote lane and the old Blacklock's Hill does allow me to safely walk home. Importantly I can gain from the health benefits walking provides. Often I meet other people walking or jogging along these routes. Any additional warehouses in this area would create more traffic on the A422 which would make it unsafe to walk or jog safely. If the proposed developments went ahead where would people from this side of town be able to walk safely? More development in these areas would also make the major routes into Banbury gridlocked. The roads can't cope now when it's rush hour or there's been an accident. We need to look after our remaining countryside and we need this green space."/> |
