I would like to register an objection to the proposed plans to the development of land on the east side of the A361 - planning application 22/00385/SO.

In the report to the local plan enquiry of 2015, the inspector stated that development on the east side of the A361 would lead to substantial landscape harm. The Overthorpe escarpment is an important landscape feature that would be ruined by the building of industrial units on the proposed site.

The access junction and local road infrastructure would not cope with a development on this scale. On a good day it struggles to flow well at the moment. The impact to local villages would be extremely detrimental and cause severe traffic problems.
