Comments	<input type="text" value="I oppose this planning application for the following reasons. - Shenington is a Category C village. Only infill and conversions should be considered. The proposed development is of the scale you would expect in a town like Banbury. - The development will mean a loss of open space, trees and have a negative impact on the wildlife. In turn this will have a negative impact of the villager's mental health and well being and cause a lot of stress. - It brings no benefit to the community - There will be traffic issues during building and afterwards - The village infrastructure is not of a standard to manage this large increase in the number of houses e.g. we already have regular power cuts - The roads become less safe for the children. Currently they can feel safe, as do the parents for their children - The whole development will be an eyesore and ruin views for many people. There has been a lack of care or consideration given to the design and look of the proposed development The bottom line is that this is a Category C village. An application of this kind should have been ruled out before it got to this stage. These categories are defined for a reason. People who move to live in a village like Shenington, like my family, moved here with an understanding that we wouldn't have to worry about a developer trying to increase the village size by a third.
