Comments	<input type="text" value="The sewerage system for the adjacent villages of Shenington and Alkerton runs through our neighbours garden. The pipe is already far too small for the existing properties linked to it, and it blocks frequently. This results in the Waterboard operatives spending many hours unblocking the pipe. When this is happening, there is usually disruption to the traffic in Well Lane. If this development goes ahead and adds so many new properties, the whole system would need updating and enlarging. Has the developer addressed this problem? We can't see that they have. Are they just expecting some one else (ie the Council?!) to pick up the tab for it?"/>
