<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I oppose this planning application for the following reasons. Adding more housing will impact the already struggling drainage issues, resulting in more flooding lower down the village. The new housing will also impact the water pressure of existing houses which is already in a poor state. Adding new houses will cause a large increase in traffic going in and out of the village, this is due to poor public transport links and lack of infrastructure (eg. no shop within the village). The roads in and out of the village are in poor condition and are narrow, so more traffic would be hazardous, especially at the blind bend in Alkerton. Additionally, the increase in traffic combined with flooding issues due to drainage problems would further decrease safety on the road and increase the likelihood of accidents occurring."/>
