Our roads are narrow, with no pavements, and being a small village, there are always people, including children, walking &amp; riding down the middle of the road. Also, we have a very limited bus schedule, and no other public transport. This proposal just not seem to be feasible in any way. And that is without considering the impact on the character and appearance of village - a village that has a conservation area, and is a Category C village which is supposed to mean that only infill and redevelopment is permitted! Surely developments such as this one proposed are more suited to a medium size town, which has the infrastructure to support the additional residents?"/>
