The proposed development is neither infill nor minimal adding almost 50% more dwellings to this small community. 2) it will have an extremely negative impact upon the integrity of this outstandingly beautiful village, gravely detracting from that beauty. 3) it will result in a dramatic decline in the basic village amenities, including drainage, sewerage, water supply, highways, power, broadband, education, medical, aesthetics etc, resulting in a very major decline in the quality of life of all residents. 4) I find it inconceivable that the developers are not aware of these major drawbacks and so can only surmise that their profits come before the basic needs of village residents, present and future."/>
