The road through the village is not suitable for the increased traffic flow that this development would generate. The road is narrow and there are no pavements, therefore presenting an increased risk to pedestrians. Water System. The Shutford Waste Water Treatment Works is already working at capacity and there are historic issues regarding the discharge of effluent in Alkerton. This development would therefore add further pressure to an already stretched system. Construction Materials. The village is built mainly from local Hornton stone. The proposed development is not only being built using red engineering bricks, but will be visible from an AONB as it is on high ground."/>
