Comments	<input type="text" value="We have a specific objection to register about the proposed development by Elan Homes concerning waste/sewage. Our property currently has a septic tank and we have taken it as given that since other village residents have been told they cannot be connected to mains sewage nor can we. The reason given, we understand, is that the system is already at capacity, with narrow bores to the waste pipes, and cannot cope with any additional demand. We have begun the process of seeking agreement to be connected, but do not have much hope. With this in mind, we do not see how the Elan development can possibly be considered - even at a preliminary stage - until ALL existing Shenington and Alkerton properties, including ours, have been connected to the mains sewage system."/>
