Public transport is very limited and every house will need its own vehicle(s) which will add to the traffic problem and danger. 4. The school is at capacity. 5. There is little point in providing affordable housing if there are no jobs locally for the people and no public transport to take them to centres of population where employment might be available. 6. There is no shop in the village and so again cars will be needed by the new residents 7. The scale of the development would have a detrimental effect on the village in all the ways listed above."/>
