Thank you for reconsulting Sport England with additional information including a revised Design and Access statement and revised Development Framework Plan CSA/3263/123 Rev H.

It is disappointing to see that both documents still do not give the same amount of proposed playing field. (para 4.3.5 in the D & A still gives it as 4.25 hectares and the plan 4 hectares! I note that in elsewhere in the D and A, t it gives it as 4 hectares! In figure 4.3 the applicants are hedging their bets by quoting both figures 4 and 4.25.).

We are also concerned over the shape the allocated formal sports facilities which will make it difficult to rotate pitches as and when needed to reduce maintenance costs and deal with areas of the pitches wearing out.

This site has been a matter of much discussion between CDC and the playing pitch steering group. As mentioned in the my previous emails: 8th and 29th April 2022, we have a concern that the area of land being put forward for a football hub, is not sufficient. However, we have been informed that additional land would be made available in the future public open space. This would overcome our concern.

When we receive written conformation of this we will withdraw our planning objection.
