We write to provide an update on the archaeological discussions that have recently been taking place with Oxfordshire County Council. Our appointed Archaeologist (EDP) has been in liaison with Victoria Green at OCC regarding the required archaeological works that need to be undertaken prior to the commencement of development at Oxford North.

We have attached the latest correspondence which shows the Victoria has accepted the Written Scheme of Investigation (also attached) that was prepared by EDP.
