Comments

I strongly object to this application for the following reasons. 1. I do not believe that it fits in with the Councils local plan as this is agricultural land and not brown field site which should have priority for planning of this type. It will also have a detrimental effect on villages within its sight line. 2. I believe this development will have a massively detrimental effect on the local environment. No development of this size could be built without increasing traffic movements, light pollution and air quality issues. This is an area of precious countryside with a delicate eco system made up of small copses and hedgerows which offer a safe haven for local wildlife. This will all be lost. 3. This is not an ideal position for a development of this kind. The site is not in a suitable location. The local road network is already overstretched. Baynards Green Roundabout has long traffic queues in both morning and evening peak times. Turning right onto the B4100 from the Stoke Lyne and Hardwick turnings is already difficult due to traffic volumes and this will only be made worse. There is no reason for positioning these units here when there is already similar developments of this kind in Bicester and Banbury.
