Traffic congestion - the access to and from the M40 has already had to be re-designed in order to cope with the volume of traffic currently using the A43, increased volumes will cause significant problems to already congested roads used for local traffic, traffic to Oxford and traffic crossing between the M40 and M1. There is already a vast and growing logistics hub less than 10 miles for the proposed site and this is on industrial land. Anything within site of this area is blighted but there is a lot of room for expansion here without destroying very long established communities and in a lot of cases areas of conservation. The environmental impact is an obvious problem both from light pollution as well as the pollutants - dust, smoke etc - from HGV's.
