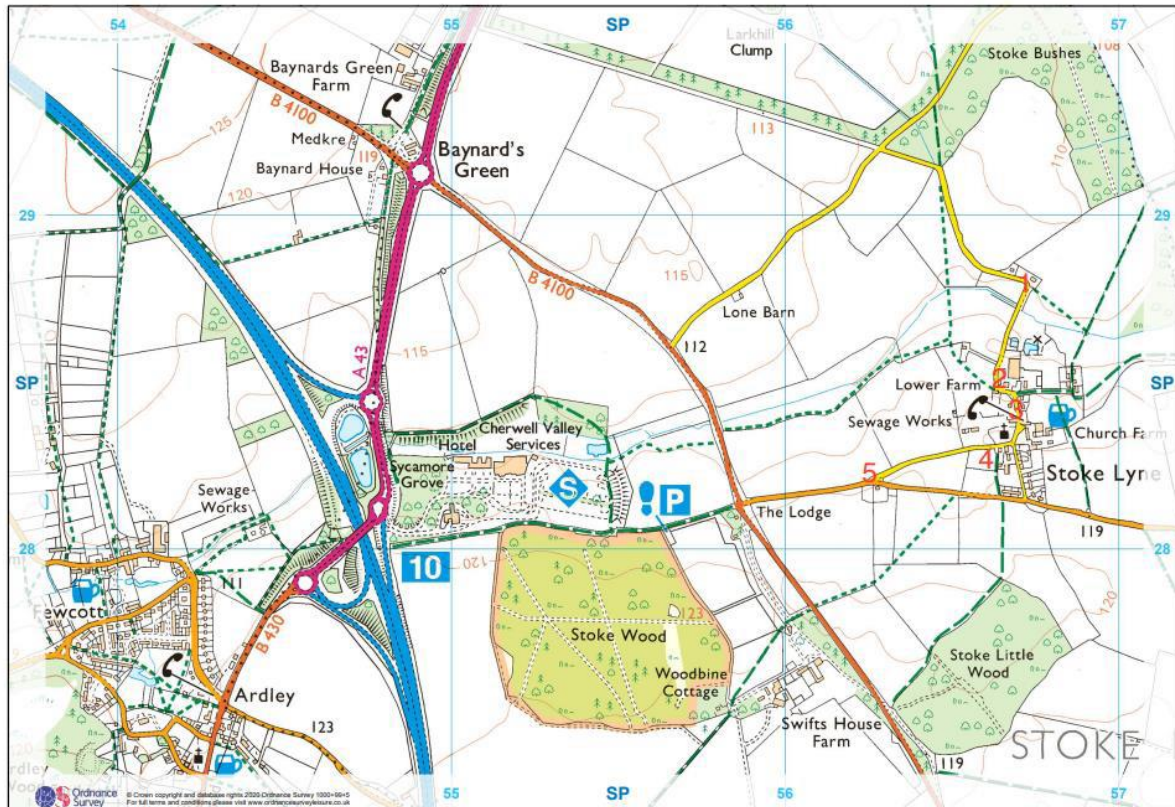


As described in the formal objection, reference is made to the map and corresponding photographs shown below. These show that the views from Stoke Lyne across the proposed site for development are currently unobstructed and that Ardley/ Fewcott can be seen. The proposed buildings will change the landscape and character of the area dramatically to the detriment of the local environment, wildlife, residents and history of the area. The fact that this proposal is being put forward is surprising, seeing as there are over 50 Hectares of allocated land for employment elsewhere in the Cherwell area.
