The current status of traffic in both Fritwell and Ardley is completely unmanageable at many times of the day, when there is additional traffic congestion caused by frequent accidents on theM40, A43, B4300 and A34 the traffic through fritwell ardley and baynards green increases exponentially creating incredibly unsafe road situations through the village and making it almost impossible for my children and I to cross the road in the village as vehicles use it is used as a 'rat run'. An increase in the number of vehicles, both in freight terms and general cars for employees will increase the potential for further accidents and also increase the volume of traffic using the villages to get to the new development making it even more dangerous to walk and navigate the village, particularly for children and the elderly. is currently no provision for pedestrian crossings in the village making it almost impossible to cross the road at these busy times.

I am also fairly shocked, given the current climate change concerns and rising price of fuel that a development such as this would be considered given that there are many unused depots in both Bicester and Banbury, both of which are within 10 miles of this proposed development, is this really necessary and will there be a need for this further development, i think it very unlikely.

To illustrate this point i have attached photos of the most recent afternoon when an accident occurred on the junction 10 roundabout, this brought the entire village to absolute gridlock and when cars were able to move they were driving very aggresivly through the village not making it very difficult for me/my children to get home after school.
