I strongly object to this application. Cherwell District Council have to consider the impact extra traffic involved with this application and the affect upon the roundabout at J11 of the M40 and the surrounding roads.

The 2 warehouses near this roundabout, on the A361, have yet to be used so the traffic going to and from them has not yet been experienced. How can more warehousing be granted permission before an actual, rather than theoretical rise in traffic levels have been seen from as yet unused warehousing in the same location?
