Comments	<input type="text" value="I fully support this long-overdue application. I have been a resident of Horley for nearly 18 years and support the Parish Council in their attempt to solve the parking problems at the Wroxton end of Horley. I am speaking as a disabled person who requires a wheeled appliance to get around. Trying to negotiate that area of the village, the lack of a footpath in itself is a major issue. However, when cars or other vehicles park on the verges and private land my attempt to navigate past becomes extremely hazardous. I am forced to use the road to get past. The sight line in both directions gives approaching vehicles very little time to foresee obstacles such as me trying to pass through. Horley is a beautiful village and the grass verges add a tremendous amount to the visual appeal. I can see no logical reason for refusing the application based on the safety and disability aspects alone. We have the best interests of our village at heart. From a pure safety angle, why should I have to put my life at risk when a practical solution has presented itself. In addition, emergency vehicles would have no chance of getting through. Nobody wishes to see the lives of people put at risk for lack of a small and well-hidden car park."/>
