Comments	<input type="text" value="The car parking in Horley has become dangerous. The bottom of Wroxton Lane, where the new parking area is proposed, has become congested and an eyesore as you enter the village. Cars have completely eroded the verges and are parked on both sides of the lane so large vehicles and farm machinery can't get through. Emergency vehicles are also unable to get past the cars parked on both sides. The village was not designed for each household to have several cars and it is essential that provision is made for cars to be parked off the road.
