Comments	<p>Although we do not object to this on principle we have the following concerns:</p> <p>One of the first things you see when entering the village from Wroxton will be the car park - we would hope that evergreen and established planting will be used to reduce the negative impact on the currently unspoilt view, in addition to dampening any additional noise as this will have a big impact on our house.</p> <p>Will a height restriction be imposed to prevent unwanted vehicles being able to access the site: camper vans, unwanted overnight stays etc?</p> <p>Are the existing grass verges going to be reinstated to a level where vehicles can no longer be driven on ?</p> <p>Lighting has not been mentioned on the proposed plans. Should this change then we feel that this would be detrimental to the village entrance as this would highlight that there is a car park and not a green field.</p>
