I believe that the construction of 500 more properties as proposed by Blenheim is not a good idea. It has already been turned down and for good reason. It will cause a lot of stress upon the existing habitants of Woodstock and its infrastructure as well as cause build-up of traffic and create a loss of countryside and urbanise the area. This won't be any good for anyone currently living here in Woodstock or new residents who would move in.

This also goes against Blenheim's eco goals as building 500 houses more would only increase pollution.

I also think that the 500 new inhabitants that Blenheim wants wouldn't be very happy with their houses so close to the airport which would disturb them every day. Like how many residents here wouldn't enjoy listening or seeing construction for the coming years.

This would also heavily impact traffic and would slow it down especially near places like the roundabout of Bladon.

As a resident of Park View, I appreciate the effort Blenheim has put in to make new houses look nice and overall planning to make the area look more established. However, 500 more houses is way too much.
