| Comments | <input developments."="" eco-friendly"="" type="text" value="I object to this planning proposal on the following grounds: An extra 500 houses, in addition to the 300 already being built, and a further 430 applied for to the north and north east of Woodstock, will increase the size of the town by 41% and exceed the maximum number allocated in the local plan by 130. How is this compatible with Transport infrastructure - the major and minor roads around Woodstock are already very busy, especially during the morning and afternoon rush hours with commuters travelling to and from work and children arriving and departing Marlborough School. If all of the planning applications are approved this would result in at least 1200 extra vehicles using Woodstock's surrounding roads and cause an intolerable increase in traffic. The Doctor's surgery in Woodstock is situated on old, cramped buildings and despite the incredible efforts of all the staff, it can barely cope with the current number of patients - where will all the new residents go for first line medical treatment? The schools in Woodstock do not have capacity for the extra schoolchildren if all the developments are built - it is estimated that 111 primary school age children will need to find places elsewhere, and be driven there.
