Natural England has previously commented on this proposal and made comments to the authority in our letter dated 20<sup>th</sup> July 2022 (Our Ref: 399441) – a copy of which is attached for your reference. Incidentally, I do not appear to be able to locate this response on the Cherwell DC website. Would it be possible to have this uploaded for reasons of continuity.

The advice provided in our previous response applies equally to this submission although we made no objection to the original proposal.
