Comments	Infrastructure in around the town of Woodstock does not support any additional dwellings -

Infrastructure in around the town of Woodstock does not support any additional dwellings - schools, surgery, roads and parking are often cited but the Thames Water discharge map, released in January 2023, makes it very clear that less discussed infrastructure is not coping with existing housing. At the date of this comment, 10/1/23, the Woodstock storm overflow has been discharging sewage into the River Glyme since 28/12/22 - for over 321 hours. It is wet January but not unseasonably so. The discharges across the region covered by Thames Water make it clear waste water systems need very significant improvement before more pressure is put on them. The problem is especially bad in West Oxfordshire where the majority of storm overflows are currently discharging sewage into rivers and have been since the map was first made publicly available. Further development in this area is untenable until this issue is resolved for the current housing stock - with capacity built in to cater for any additional housing.
