<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="I strongly object to this development. Over development in Oxfordshire is becoming an eyesore on the environment. The local infrastructure is unable to cope with the current increase in traffic from the first phase of the site that is currently still under construction. Locals that now live on the estate are complaining that exiting the estate is becoming increasingly dangerous and is an accident waiting to happen. Adding a further 500 homes to the area will add a further 1500 cars arriving and leaving the site twice a day (excluding visitors and day trippers). In addition the number of deliveries being made is naturally increasing and again makes movement around the estate hazardous. Woodstock as a town can't cope with such an increase in local traffic. Amenities, drs, schools etc will be overwhelmed. The link road between the current site under construction and the new estate is totally disingenuous and is being marketed in an u der hand way. When we purchased on the current estate there was no mention of a further 500 homes or a connecting road. The connecting road will increase traffic immeasurably. The Sale of our home was made under false pretences. When we did our searches this did NOT show up in searches - as Blenheim kept it under wraps - but took our money."/>
