as a local resident, living in Sibford Ferris, I am astonished that despite a previous application, a previous objection and subsequent previous declination, the same application is being submitted again for your consideration. I am confused as to why another application with no differences is allowed to be resubmitted.?

In summary we firmly believe the proposal constitutes unnecessary, inappropriate and unstatainable development extending beyond the built up limits of the village and the attractive open countryside surrounding Sibford Ferris. Its layout form, design and location for older people is unsuitable and fails to respond to the local character, landscape and surrounding context and should be refused as harming the visual and rural amenities of the area

Our small, beloved village appears under continual and constant attack following permission being granted for 25 houses in Hook Norton Road

The village is simply not capable of coping with any more traffic. The infrastucuture is aged, limited and there is real danger of serious accident with increased traffic flow through very narrow already built up roads.

The village sits some 7 miles away from the nearest town, with little infrustracture to support an siginicant increase in population.

In addition this proposal is contrary to the local plan, unsuitable, generate harmful environmental issues such as traffic, emissions, of poor layout and design contrary to NPPF and national design guide,
