Comments	<p>We are Sibford Ferris residents and live on Woodway Road opposite Faraday House with 31 acres of paddocks on both sides of The Sib Valley.</p> <p>We wish to endorse and support the objections made by The Sibford Action Group which sets out with supporting evidence on why this resubmitted application should be rejected again.</p> <p>We would add one further grounds for objection. The world is likely to face a significant continuing shortage of fossil fuel, cereal[especially wheat, barley and oats], vegetable oils as well as fertiliser as a result of the desperate situation in Ukraine. There are already substantial increases in food prices as a result. The Government is urging the country to become more self sufficient in food. If approved this development will destroy more prime farming land [given that 10 acres next door have already been lost to development] and create further car dependent population who will be predominantly fossil fuel based for some time to come. The proposal is the antithesis of sustainability further expanding a relatively isolated village which is dependent for nearly everything from employment to food being delivered on poor, dangerous and overloaded roads. This development should be rejected again and the land restored to growing food. Development needs to be in major employment centres where people can live sustainably.</p>
