The Walnut Tree we wish to have reduced is shown in green, and labelled A.

Other trees on our property are shown as blue circles.

Some of the other trees in neighbouring properties are shown in yellow.

I estimate the diameter of the tree canopy to be approximately 12 metres—though the diameter varies, depending on branches.

Our property is the house on the right of the picture. The tree overhangs our neighbour's garden and drive.

Bottom left of the picture is our neighbour's car (Number 1 White Horses Close.)

We have been concerned, in windy weather, about debris falling on his car. We have had fairly sizeable branches dropped in the autumn.

When we last applied for and had the tree pruned, in the summer of 2007, we were advised by a visitor from the council that it was in decline, though though it might take a number of years.

If it were considered appropriate, we are happy to have the tree removed and plant another tree.
