Comments	<p>I object for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. This development will basically surround Withycombe Farm, a Grade II listed, and a beautiful 17th century farm in our Parish.2. This is a greenfield site which is used for food production, which is pretty important as we head into a major food crisis. Meanwhile, there are 10 brownfield sites in Banbury including Canalside which has already been flagged up as part of the Local Plan (2017 - 2022) to supply 700 dwellings. In addition to being a brownfield site, which in my opinion should always be the first choice over greenfield sites, imagine how this development would help regenerate, rejuvenate and bring life back into Banbury town centre!
