Find an alternative native to Betula pendula which is ubiquitous.


P9 Cutting wildflower mixes down to 25mm is too low, much of the plant will be lost or weakened. 75 mm is better. P14 Add to Annual technical inspection 'RoSPA' or similar

P23 wildflower meadows need 2 cuts a year, usually March and August/September. Do not keep at 150mm or they won't flower.
