The primary school is operating close to capacity (and has been for a number of years) due to the number of army families in the village and the increase in families moving to the village and surrounding villages. The impact on the road junctions with the increase in the number of vehicles will be significant (particularly at peak times). The current traffic light work on Ploughy Road is taking far longer than initially suggested and will not help vehicles heading towards Aylesbury who are going to be forced past the school entrance on Blackthorn Road (where there is no safe crossing from springfields estate), to turn right from the B4011, which is on the brow of the hill with no clear view in either direction.

This has several potentially accident possibilities when there are already a relatively high number of accidents on the A41 at the Blackthorn turn, in addition to the risk to pedestrians in the village.

The Ocado junction is also not traffic lighted and has large numbers of vehicles in and out.
