Comments

It is plain to see that the infrastructure of the village is not sufficient to support its current residents, let alone further development - particularly of this type and scale. There is a complete lack of local amenities, in addition to limited school places and poor quality road infrastructure currently. This is exacerbated by the poor design of the disastrous new Ploughley Road junction from the A41 making this development completely inappropriate for the local area. We are overrun with unused and poorly maintained local play parks which, as far as I can ascertain from the planning documents, is the only "infrastructure" being offered by this colossal development.
