- The lack of appropriate road infrastructure to support the increased traffic flow to the village when our roads are already struggling to cope with the traffic at present
- The lack of suitable amenities being provided to support the growing size of the village (a problem which has been magnified by other recent developments within the village). The only amenities which seem to be offered are play parks. This village is drowning in play parks which are all serving one particular age group and do not benefit the wider village and its residents. The wider village needs school places, an adequate shop to cope with the demand of the increased volume of residents and general community infrastructure. It is unreasonable to expect our existing village centre alone to provide amenities for a village which is constantly increasing in size.
