As a district councillor for Ambrosden I have had many people contact me regarding this application. Based on the feedback and my own concerns I object due to the following.

- -Noise from the worksite, the village has had this problem non-stop for years from other developments
- -Road traffic will be increased even more than the current homes still being built.
- -Concerns that the biodiversity reports and checks were done correctly and does not show what is truly there.
- -Ambrosden is taking more than its fair share of houses over the past few years compared with elsewhere.
- -Poor public transport, this development will leave more people stuck without access to town.
- -infrastructure needs much more improvement before any more larger developments are built.
- -Ambrosden is currently seeing over development
- -Local schools can not support many more pupils with some real investment and extensions. Doing this little by little is not effective.
- -Lack of community facilities for teenagers.
