<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="Ambrosden has already had and is still undergoing a number of housing developments. This is putting a strain on local amenities and utilities. There has been growth in housing but nothing for infrastructure support such as schooling, shops, amenities for younger people (we do not need more playparks), or older people, or transport links. Housing has been built on floodplains, and despite drainage schemes in place there is significant flooding on land off Ploughley Road. Traffic continues to grow, and the current debacle of works on the A41 shows how fragile the traffic situation is. What was once a pleasant rural village is slowly expanding to meet and merge with Bicester, with no thought of the environmental impact. I do not agree to yet another housing estate being built with no overall plan for the viillage."/>
