We have the following comments on the consultation responses so far:

Oxfordshire County Council Response to Consultation:

Page 19. Bridleway Connection. Why has there been no mention of consulting the land owners which are Ambrosden Residents Company Limited? No adjustment to the Bridleway or access can be made without permission from the landowner. OCC or the Local Planning Authority have no basis to approve the pedestrian access or any alterations without landowners permission. Neither this pathway nor this estate have been adopted by OCC or Cherwell DC. The land over which this bridleway travels and the hedgerow boundary, is definitively owned by Ambrosden Residents Company Limited. The Ambrosden Residents Company Limited have never been consulted or approached by anybody over this development. This shows the disregard and contempt that the developers and planners have for us on this estate.

Thames Valley Police Response to Consultation:
