## Key issues:

The plan does not reflect the triggers in the S106 agreement.

## **Detailed comments:**

- Trigger for completion is only mentioned for the bus route. The trigger is defined
  in the S106 agreement, in relation to the 'Bus Route and Primary HGV Access'
  which includes Chilgrove Drive, as well as the provision of a loop road accessing
  the school (Sixteenth Schedule Clause 2). So these should all be part of the
  same phase.
- The triggers for the other elements (where set in the S106) should be mentioned in the legend.
- The school access road loop should be shown on the plan and referenced, with its trigger, in the legend.
- Works labelled C and D (Chilgrove Drive junction and improvements to Camp Road, also have triggers set in the S106 (where they are referred to Works packages A and B respectively).
- Active travel elements of infrastructure from the composite parameter plan are not included, including primary pedestrian/cycle routes and bridleways.
- Clarification is needed around the residential road infrastructure for phase 12 does it include an access to the existing road network? This isn't necessarily a
  problem (subject to assessment), it just wasn't shown as an access on the
  parameter plan.
