Access from the busy A4095 is very dangerous from both sides, visibility is poor, where a 50mph speed limit now turns into a 20mph. There is no justification in developing here, and certainly no benefit to the local community, and would mean the loss of significant habitat for the foxes, birds, badgers and muntjac deer we see in this area.
