<b>Comments</b>	<p>I object to this planning application on multiple levels, but most importantly, it does not fulfil the needs of the village, which is in need of affordable housing. The access is off a busy road on a blind corners. It does not connect with the village other than via a muddy footpath. Both these points mean that the residents of the proposed development will be forced to use their cars for all journeys, contributing to the traffic problems, and leaving them isolated from contributing to village life. There is a clear opportunity for this planning application to lead to further applications on the Greenfield site, which is outside the village boundary, and a similar larger application has been rejected before. The village requires affordable housing which should be located within the village itself, not on green field spaces outside the village boundary.</p>
