Comments

I object to the planning application for a Solar Park at Mill Lane, Stratton Audley because the land in question is good quality crop yielding land. Members of my family have in the past successfully farmed this particular piece of land and the current applicant was recently granted planning permission by Cherwell for a grain barn in which the application submitted was for a higher than average yield of grain. Solar Parks should be developed on brown field sites or on the roofs of commercial buildings in Bicester. The effect on environmental diversity will be devastating.
