Comments	<input type="text" value="I moved to Chesterton 5 years ago and I have always lived in villages, for the last 48 years. Soon after we arrived, we realised how badly this village of Chesterton had been treated. It has had to accept a huge amount of building. Two recent estates in the village and the massive Kingsmere, nearby. The Wolf project was also given the go ahead despite huge objections.
