Comments	<input type="text" value="No, no, no, just no. We have had more than our fair share of disruption, with not only the 2 housing estates, but Great Wolf and the BSA sports ground. We are a smallish village with no real amenities apart from the pub and no bus route, so all transport has to be by private vehicles adding to the ever growing pollution levels. There is no way a walk/cycle path can be put in place leading to endangerment of life to pedestrians and dog walkers due to the increased traffic that will occur on a very narrow road. This will also lead to an increased risk of traffic instances/accidents, the road would need to be substantially widened which will again destroy well established hedges and natural wildlife either nesting or burrowing in said hedges. Chesterton has seen recent flooding, this has to be due to the interruption of the natural water table from the 2 new estates, the current water table WILL be displaced again leading to more issues in the future. Chesterton village is not supported by mains gas and therefore there will be additional disruption in the laying of utility services. What is the justification of destroying more of our natural green fields, well established flora and fauna, displacing the wildlife, increasing pollution both noise, light, vehicle and general pollution. I strongly oppose this planning application and hope the sensible decision will be made to decline this."/>
