Comments	<input type="text" value="I wish to object in the strongest possible terms to this application. Chesterton cannot support such a large number of new houses. The proposed site is liable to flood, it always is water logged as soon as there is any significant rainfall. The sewers and drainage in the village cannot cope at the moment- the only pumping station on the outskirts of the village floods over into the road when there is excess water in the system. The roads are not suitable for the additional amount of traffic that this development would create - 147 houses equates to approximately 300 extra cars - and please do not suggest that people could use public transport instead!! We have already had far in excess housing built in the village over and above the figures originally in the Local Plan. We have the astronomical effects of the Wolf development to cope with which will overload excessively everything- roads, drainage, light pollution, landscape impact, environmental pollution- everything and we cannot sustain this development as well. As ever these applications are made on grounds of greed and not for the benefit of the existing community. I object very vehemently."/>
