This application is speculative and the site is not in the current approved Local Plan. As Cherwell has over 5 years land supply at present there is no need for this application.

The infrastructure in the village is at close or over capacity as follows:-

Water - Thames have expressed concerns about supply to this development

Sewage - At times of heavy rain there is raw sewage in the road near a pumping station so where will the extra waste water go

School - This is at capacity and more children would result in extra car journeys out of the village

Health Provision - The Bicester provision is currently inadequate and this can only get worse with the Hub at Graven Hill not going ahead

Safe Routes - there is no safe walking or cycling route from the village to Bicester The proposed development would result in the loss of wildlife habitat. We would ask Cherwell District Council to refuse this application.
