<b>Comments</b>	<input type="text" value="If allowed this would devastate the countryside, remove wildlife habitat &amp; increase problems with traffic in the area. This has a knock on effect for traffic right across Banbury. This is currently a green area which is significant for wildlife having not been changed dramatically for centuries. The recent Butterfly population report shows that 80% of our Butterflies have declined over time and that includes the Banbury area where some species have disappeared altogether. Developments like this are one of the causal factors. The scale and height of the proposal will decimate the local area and put precious wildlife at risk. It will also be a huge blot on the landscape, ruin the northeastern entrance to Banbury and set an unwelcome precedent for future proposals. To anyone approaching Banbury from the M40, Daventry or Brackley it will seem like Banbury is just a series of giant warehouses."/>
