I am writing from the Countryside Access Team at Oxfordshire County Council regarding the above application to provide comments in relation to public rights of way (ROW).

RIGHTS OF WAY – Deddington

- Footpath 187/2/20

Key issues:

- The development is in the proximity of the above right of way.

Recommendation: No objections. This response is for the purpose of raising awareness of the public right of way on the corner of Earls Lane and Castle Street. No development activity should interfere with the public right of access here.

Temporary obstructions. No materials, plant, temporary structures or excavations of any kind should be deposited / undertaken on **or adjacent** to the Public Right of Way that may obstruct or dissuade the public from using the public right of way whilst development takes place. Reason: To ensure the public right of way remains available and convenient for public use.
