Comments	<input type="text" value="We agreed to the original plans on the basis that there was 'natural buffer' of trees and planting to shield the new houses from the Deddington Castle Grounds. As sadly happens often, the original drawings - which were presented as being considerate to their surroundings - were seemingly just a hook to obtain planning. This new revised plan does not feature those elements which enabled agreement in the first place. Though overgrown (due to lack of funding and care), the Deddington Castle Grounds is a unique 11th century monument and an asset to this village and should therefore be respected as such. This revised plan, does not consider its special surroundings, encroaches the Castle Grounds and I therefore object. We agreed to the original scheme and that is the plan that should be realised, not this."/>
